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1. Getting Started With Lessons

We deliver 38x 1-2-1 lessons per academic year on a weekly basis during term time dependent on location. In addition, all our students get priority booking for any Masterclasses run at the studio.

2. Owning Instruments

Depending on where you are in your musical journey so far, our teachers will help you in choosing or maintaining your drums, guitar or piano. If you are new to playing, we do not expect or require you to own your own instrument.



If you are keen to keep learning, we normally recommend investing in an instrument in the first 3-6 months. We have industry contacts that will work with you to ensure you are getting the best instrument for your needs.



3. Your Investment

For your convenience, investment in lessons is spread out over 12 months via a monthly direct debit of £106.08 for our Roundwood Park School/Katherine Warrington School facilities and £112.16 for The Music Den Studio. These figures are based on 38x 30-minute lessons per year from the commencement of tuition. The monthly direct debit remains in place until notice to cancel has been received. If you wish to stop lessons we require a full terms notice via email. Hourly lessons are double the investment shown above.

4. Your Time

For students studying up to grade 5, lessons are 30 minutes. Students working at a level of Grade 5 and over, 1-hour weekly lessons are recommended. Adult students may also choose to take 1-hour lessons. Tuition is delivered on a one-2-one, face-2-face basis by our team and tailored to suit your personal goals and needs. Online lessons are available upon request.

5. Practice Time

Students are given a tailored practice plan to help with their progress based on their specific needs. We recommend they practice four times for at least 20-minutes in between lessons to ensure consistent progress.

6. Our Curriculum

We are happy to teach from all the known syllabuses and also have written much of our own content based on our time studying and performing all over the world. Our focus is always to inspire our students to develop a passion for the instrument by making the lessons as fun and interactive as possible. Unlike other schools, what and how we teach you is based on our combined 100 years experience and focuses on the specific goals the student is aiming for.
